

## **RESOLUTION NO. 6006**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MAYWOOD ESTABLISHING THE APPROPRIATION LIMIT IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE XIII B OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE FISCAL YEARS 13/14, 14/15, 15/16, 16/17, 17/18 AND 18/19.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Maywood is required pursuant to the provisions of Article XIII B of the Constitution of the State of California to establish its appropriation limit by resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Government Code Section 37200, the calculation of the limit and the total appropriations subject to the limit were set forth in the annual budget of the City of Maywood for Fiscal Years 13/14, 14/15, 15/16, 16/17, 17/18 and 18/19, adopted by ordinance of the Council; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Government Code Section 7901 and 7910, the final calculation of the limit has been determined, and the adjustment factors on which the calculations is based are from the percentage change in California per capita and the percentage change in the population growth in its jurisdiction or from the surround county. For population growth, pursuant to Government Code Section 7901 (b), the City will be using population growth in Los Angeles County; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MAYWOOD AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That pursuant to Article XIII B, Section 1, of the Constitution of California and Section 7900-7914 of the Government Code of the State of California, the City appropriation limit must be adjusted for changes from the base year of 1986-87 to the fiscal years ending June 30<sup>th</sup>, by the changes in the California per capita personal income and the changes in population.

**SECTION 2.** That the California Department of Finance has notified the City of the change in the California per capita personal income and such change is from the prior calendar years.

**SECTION 3.** That the California Department of Finance has notified the City of the change in City or County population and such change is a percent from the prior calendar year.

**SECTION 4.** That the Notice of Public Hearing and State of California Department of Finance calculation factors are hereby approved and by this reference are incorporated as set forth in its entirety.

**SECTION 5.** That the appropriation limits for the fiscal years 13/14, 14/15, 15/16, 17/18, and 18/19 have been calculated and did not exceed the limitations imposed by Proposition 4 (Gann Amendment).

**SECTION 6.** That the appropriation limit for fiscal year 2013/14 for the City of Maywood is established at \$8,870,171, and did not exceed the appropriation subject to limit of \$3,103,550 imposed by Proposition 4 “Gann Amendment”.

**SECTION 7.** That the appropriation limit for fiscal year 2014/15 for the City of Maywood is established at \$8,918,798, and did not exceed the appropriation subject to limit of \$2,912,755 imposed by Proposition 4 “Gann Amendment”.

**SECTION 8.** That the appropriation limit for fiscal year 2015/16 for the City of Maywood is established at \$9,335,424, and did not exceed the appropriation subject to limit of \$2,944,620 imposed by Proposition 4 “Gann Amendment”.

**SECTION 9.** That the appropriation limit for fiscal year 2016/17 for the City of Maywood is established at \$9,920,348, and did not exceed the appropriation subject to limit of \$2,926,881 imposed by Proposition 4 “Gann Amendment”.

**SECTION 10.** That the appropriation limit for fiscal year 2017/18 for the City of Maywood is established at \$10,345,041, and did not exceed the appropriation subject to limit of \$3,302,110 imposed by Proposition 4 “Gann Amendment”.

**SECTION 11.** That the appropriation limit for fiscal year 2018/19 for the City of Maywood is established at \$10,779,400, and did not exceed the appropriation subject to limit of \$3,876,195 imposed by Proposition 4 “Gann Amendment”.

**SECTION 12.** That pursuant to Section 7910 of the Government Code of the State of California, the documents used in the determination of the appropriation limit applicable to this Resolution, have been made available for general public inspection prior to the adoption of this Resolution and during the public hearing process.

**SECTION 13.** This resolution shall take effect (15 days) after the City Clerk certifies to the adoption of this Resolution, including the documents used in the determination of the appropriation limit and made available for general public inspection after the public hearing process.

**SECTION 14.** That the City Council of the City of Maywood reserves the right to change or revise any growth factor associated with the calculation of the appropriation limit if such changes or revisions would result in a more advantageous appropriation limit.

**SECTION 15.** Adopt Resolution providing for the appropriation and expenditures for all sums set forth in said budget and repealing all resolutions in conflict herewith.


