



## Notice from the City of Maywood

June 5, 2020 at 7:30 p.m.:

The County of Los Angeles Department of Public Health (LADPH) announced **ONE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED AND FORTY-FIVE** (1,445) new confirmed novel coronavirus (COVID-19) in one day, bringing us to a total of **THREE HUNDRED AND FORTY-THREE** (343) confirmed cases overall in the City of Maywood. Due to patient confidentiality, no further information on the identity of the residents has been released by the LADPH authorities.

Los Angeles County (LAC) is now in the advanced stages of Phase 2 of the State's Resilience Roadmap. This new phase of LAC's reopening better aligns the County with neighboring counties, moving Southern California towards a regional recovery and supporting our service-oriented businesses, many of which are small and locally owned, it's a testament to the efforts of residents who adhered to the Safer At Home order, practiced social distancing and wore cloth face coverings.

**The new openings are part of a phased progression guiding the safe resumption of public life in LAC that include:**

- Barbershops and hair salons
- In-person dining in restaurants
- In-person faith-based services
- In-store shopping at retail stores,
- Bike paths and other recreational pursuits. The LADPH will amend its Health Officer Order accordingly.

**Still closed:**

- Gyms and fitness centers
- Personal grooming (Nail salons, Spa services, including massage, facials and waxing)

LAC is under a Safer at Work and In The Community for Control of COVID-19 order and public and private gatherings of people outside of a single household unit are not permitted except for public protests and faith-based services, which are permitted to operate with limits on the number of participants. Everyone must continue to follow physical distancing and infection control protocols and wear a cloth face covering when in contact with others not in your household.

A friendly reminder to please do your part and take all measures our local and state partners recommend keeping you and your families healthy. Do not have non-essential gatherings with anyone outside of your immediate family (living with you). Essential gatherings only include medical visits and purchasing food. Serious cases are occurring across Los Angeles County. Please stay home and if you must go out, it is very important that you practice social distancing (6 feet away). These efforts will not only assist in flattening the curve but will save lives.

In light of the death of George Floyd and the national protests against police brutality, Mayor Eddie De La Riva has released the following statement on behalf of the entire Maywood community in regarding the death of George Floyd.

*"I unequivocally condemn the killings of George Floyd, Breonna Taylor, Ahmaud Arbery and so many others before them. Their senseless deaths are sadly the most recent examples of a long and inexcusable history of systemic racism, discrimination, oppression, and violence toward people of color in our country. The recent killing of George Floyd and wider events have been horrific and highlight wider systems of inequality. In Maywood, we have a responsibility to influence, change, and help tackle the issues that threaten the lives of Black Americans. With enduring understanding, empathy, and a peaceful resolve, we are committed to advocate for the change our country needs today for a better future."*
