



NOTICE FROM THE CITY OF MAYWOOD

Dear Maywood Community:

Today, the [County of Los Angeles](#) announced the first steps towards reopening our community.

Beginning on May 8, select non-essential businesses may open with curbside pick-up that follow physical distancing and infection control guidelines. This includes bookstores, clothing stores, florists, sporting goods stores, music stores, toy stores and car dealership showrooms that practice physical distancing and infection control guidelines.

In addition, trails and golf courses will be permitted to open as long as everyone adheres to physical distancing and infection control guidelines. .

The re-opening of all businesses will occur in stages and require physical distancing and infection control practices. While we are making good progress, **it's important to remember that the COVID-19 pandemic is still active**. Residents, business owners and employees must observe physical distancing requirements and prevention techniques. This includes:

- Wearing a face covering whenever you leave home
- Washing your hands for at least 20 seconds throughout the day
- Staying six feet away from people who do not live with you

The City of Maywood is committed to adhere with the guidance provided by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, the coronavirus is still deadly and capable of quickly taking many lives. As L.A. County moves into its first stage of recovery, all residents, business owners and employees must continue to observe and practice all COVID-19 physical distancing requirements.
