COVID-19 Impacts on the Community

The City Hall located at 4319 E. Slauson Ave, is now closed for ALL walk-in services. Limited access to City Hall will be made by appointment only. Phones will be answered during business hours. If you have any questions about City services, please call (323) 562-5700.

In efforts to prevent the transmission of COVID-19, on March 19th, 2020 the County of Los Angeles has issued new restrictions on public gatherings known as the "Safer At Home" order that calls for nonessential businesses to cease operations that require workers to present in person.

- You may perform essential activities, such as picking up groceries, picking up medication and healthcare supplies
Note: supplies of groceries are expected to remain available to the community through local grocery stores. Items that are not available are expected to be replenished in the coming days.
- You may walk, hike or bike outside and participate in outdoor activities that do not involve groups of individuals while practicing social distancing

Restricted activities:

- You may not go to work unless you are providing essential services
- You may not visit friends or family if there is no urgent need
- You may not visit loved ones in the hospital, nursing home, skilled nursing facility or other residential care facilities
- You may not gather in groups larger than 10 individuals

Public spaces

- All playgrounds in Maywood (parks remain open) and fitness centers must close

Public and Private Gatherings

- Public and Private Gatherings attended by 2-9 persons, held in a confined or enclosed space, and not prohibited by the County directive, must adhere to the following:
 - Enforce social distancing by requiring attendees who remain at the gathering for over 5 minutes to be separate by at least six feet from other attendees. Individuals who attend the gathering as a group, such as family members, may sit or remain together but groups must be separated by at least six feet of space
 - Provide access to hand washing facilities with soap or water or with hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% of alcohol
 - Post a sign in a conspicuous place that instructs individuals not to attend if they have symptoms of respiratory illness, including fever or cough

Restaurants

- All restaurants and permanent food facilities must limit their services to preparing and offering food to patrons through **delivery service, pick-up, take-out or drive-thru only.**
