

**RESOLUTION NO. 6183**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
MAYWOOD, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE FINAL ENGINEER'S  
REPORT, CONFIRMING THE DIAGRAM AND ASSESSMENTS, AND  
ORDERING THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS  
WITHIN THE CITY OF MAYWOOD STREET LIGHTING  
ASSESSMENT DISTRICT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021/22 PURSUANT  
TO THE PROVISIONS OF DIVISION 15, PART 2 OF THE STREETS  
AND HIGHWAYS CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MAYWOOD (HEREAFTER REFERRED TO AS "CITY COUNCIL") HEREBY DETERMINES, FINDS AND RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**WHEREAS**, this City Council, by previous Resolutions, initiated proceedings and declared its intention to levy and collect assessments against lots and parcels of land within an existing assessment district known and designated as "THE CITY OF MAYWOOD STREET LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT" (hereinafter referred to as the "District") for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022 pursuant to the provisions of the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, Division 15, Part 2 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as the "Act"); and

**WHEREAS**, the City previously determined that the annual assessments originally established for the District were for the maintenance and operation of street lights within the public street right-of-way. As such, pursuant to Article XIII D Section 5(a), the pre-existing assessment amount has been exempted from the procedural requirements of Article XIII D Section 4 since the amount of the assessment has not increased since the passage of Proposition 218; and

**WHEREAS**, the Engineer selected by the City Council has prepared and filed with the City Clerk, and the City Clerk has presented to the City Council, the Fiscal Year 2021/22 Engineer's Report in connection with the proposed levy and collection of assessments against lots and parcels of land within the District, and the City Council did by previous Resolution approve such report on May 12, 2021;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to levy and collect assessments against lots and parcels of land within the District for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022, to pay for the costs and expenses for the improvements described in Section 5 below.

**WHEREAS**, following notice duly given, the City Council held a full and fair public hearing, and all interested persons were afforded the opportunity to hear and be heard. The City Council considered all oral and written statements, protests and communications made or filed by interested persons.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, DETERMINED, AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MAYWOOD STREET LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the above recitals are all true and correct.

**Section 2.** The City Council now declares the levy of proposed assessments against lots and parcels of land within the District for Fiscal Year 2021/22 to pay for the costs and expenses for the improvements described in Section 5 below pursuant to the terms and provisions of the Act.

**Section 3.** The City Council hereby approves the Engineer's Report described in the recitals hereof. Based upon its review of the Fiscal Year 2021/22 Engineer's Report and other reports and information, the City Council hereby finds and determines that (i) the lands within the District will be benefited by the improvements described in Section 5 below, (ii) the District includes all of the lands so benefited, and (iii) the net amount to be assessed upon the lands within the District for the 2021/22 fiscal year in accordance with the Engineer's Report is apportioned by a formula and method which fairly distributes the net amount among all assessable lots and parcels in proportion to the estimated benefits to be received by each such lot or parcel from the improvements.

**Section 4.** The diagram and assessment as presented to the City Council and on file in the office of the City Clerk are hereby confirmed as filed.

**Section 5.** The City Council hereby orders levy of the assessment and the proposed improvements to be made, which improvements are briefly described as follows: the installation, maintenance and servicing of street lighting and traffic signal facilities and appurtenant facilities throughout the District, including the replacement of existing street lighting and traffic signal facilities at various locations throughout the District.

**Section 6.** The assessment is in compliance with the provisions of the Act, the provisions of the California Constitution Article XIII D and the City Council has complied with all laws pertaining to the levy of an annual assessment.

**Section 7.** Installation, maintenance and servicing of the street lighting and traffic signal facilities and appurtenant facilities described in Section 5 above shall be performed pursuant to law.

**Section 8.** The County Auditor of Los Angeles County shall enter on the County Assessment Roll opposite each lot or parcel of land the amount of the assessment and such assessments shall then be collected at the same time and in the same manner as the County taxes are collected. After collection by the County, the net amount of the assessments, after deduction of any compensation due the county for collection, shall be paid to the City Treasurer.

**Section 9.** Public property owned by any public agency and in use for a public function and which is included within the District shall not be subject to the assessment to pay for any of the costs and expenses associated with the improvements.

**Section 10.** The City Treasurer shall deposit all moneys representing assessments collected by the County to the credit of a special fund known as "THE CITY OF MAYWOOD STREET LIGHTING ASSESSMENT DISTRICT FUND" and such moneys shall be expended only for the improvements described in Section 5 above.

**Section 11.** The adoption of this Resolution constitutes the levy of assessments for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022.


**Section 12.** The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to file the diagram and assessments, or a certified copy of the diagram and assessments, with the County Auditor, together with a certified copy of this Resolution upon its adoption.

**Section 13.** A certified copy of the diagram and assessment shall be filed in the office of the City Engineer, with a duplicate copy on file in the office of the City Clerk and open for public inspection.




