Public Safety Updates

The City officially proclaimed a local state of emergency on March 16, 2020 in response to the coronavirus pandemic. The declaration of local emergency was issued to work towards controlling the spread of the virus within our city and nationwide, as the safety of our residents, staff, and visitors remains our highest priority. We are continuing to monitor the crisis and urge everyone to stay at home except to get essential supplies or for work.

To stop the spread of COVID-19

- Cover your nose and mouth with any cloth covering before leaving your home.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick, and adhere to social distancing of at least 6 ft.
- Wash your hands often, for at least 20 seconds.

Bulky Item Pick-Up

To schedule a bulky item pickup, call UWS customer service 800-631-7016. The City ordinance states that, "It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, deposit, or place, or to cause, permit, or allow to be thrown, deposited, or dumped, upon the sidewalk or parkway or upon any private premises, whether with or without the consent of the owner or occupant." To report illegal dumping, please call City Hall at 323-562-5700.

CENSUS 2020 IS HERE!
